The authority may by rule prescribe a maximum limitation on the speed of vehicles using the turnpike, but not exceeding 55 65 miles per hour or such maximum speed as is permitted on similar roads in the State, and so limit the speed at any point or place thereon, and may regulate the volume and weight of vehicles admitted to the turnpike.

Any adjustment to 29 rate of speed established pursuant to this section shall be exempt from the provisions of the Maine Ad-30 ministrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375. 31 This section shall not apply to that portion of the 33 . interstate system which is part of the Maine Turn-
