AN ACT to Establish an Alien Trapping
License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7133, sub-§1, ¶E is enacted to
read:

E. Any nonresident alien is eligible to purchase
a nonresident alien trapping license.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7133, sub-§4, as repealed and
replaced by PL 1983, c. 807, Pt. P, §11, is repealed
and the following enacted in its place:

4. Schedule of fees. The fees for trapping li-
censes shall be as follows.
