8 9	E. Any nonresident alien is eligible to purchase a nonresident alien trapping license.
10 11 12	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7133, sub-§4, as repealed and replaced by PL 1983, c. 807, Pt. P, §11, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
13 14	4. Schedule of fees. The fees for trapping licenses shall be as follows.

6 7 8 9	This new draft makes nonresident aliens eligible to buy the alien license that is established in section 2. The alien trapping license fee is set at \$510. Resident aliens are eligible to buy a resident license.
