COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 261, L.D. 742,

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"Resolve, Creating a Watershed District Commission."

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Amend the resolve in the first paragraph, in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 8 and 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the words "House of Representatives" the following: 'and the Executive Director of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission and the Commissioner of Environmental Protection or their designees shall be ex officio, nonvoting members'

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Further amend the resolve by adding after the first paragraph a new paragraph to read:

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'Staff. Resolved: That the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission and the Department of Environmental Protection shall provide staff to the commission to conduct research and write reports for the commission; and be it further'

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Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the first and 2nd paragraphs before the statement of fact (page 2, lines 20 to 26 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

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'Report. Resolved: That the commission shall make its report, including any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government of the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature by December 31, 1987; and be it further

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**Appropriation. Resolved:** That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This amendment provides for the creation of 2 ex  
9 officio nonvoting members of the Watershed District  
10 Commission. These members shall be the Executive Di-  
11 rectors of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission  
12 and the Commissioner of Environmental Protection or  
13 their designees.

14 This amendment also provides that the Department  
15 of Environmental Protection and the Maine Land Use  
16 Regulation Commission will staff the Watershed Dis-  
17 trict Commission.

18 This amendment also provides an appropriation of  
19 \$6,160 to fund the commission.
