Increased evidence has verified the link between a reduced cholesterol level and a reduced risk of heart disease. The funds appropriated in this bill will create a Cholesterol Control Program within the Bureau of Health to conduct public and professional education, organize screening programs and advocate for organizational and environmental change to support a low cholesterol diet among Maine citizens. This program will be built upon the successful efforts of the Community High Blood Pressure Program, using many of the same community-based agencies to implement this effort. Much of the activity of this program will be in support of a recently initiated
