AN ACT to Amend the Elderly Householders Tax
and Rent Refund Act.

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4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 36 MRSA §6108, first ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c.
7 698, §189, is further amended to read:

8 No claim otherwise allowable may be granted to
9 claimants of single member households with household
10 income in excess of \$5,600 in calendar year 1980 and
11 ~~\$6,200~~ \$8,000 in each succeeding year for which re-
12 lief is requested; and no claim otherwise allowable
13 may be granted to claimants of ~~households~~ households
14 of 2 or more members with income in excess of \$6,700
15 in calendar year 1980 and ~~\$7,400~~ \$9,500 in each suc-
16 ceeding year for which relief is requested.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill will increase the income limitation on the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act thereby allowing more people to qualify under this Act.

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
