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AN ACT to Provide Group Insurance.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

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24-A MRSA §2612-B is enacted to read:

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§2612-B. State subsidized group

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The superintendent shall contract with an insurer
authorized to sell health insurance in the State to
establish a group health plan which will provide
health insurance for individuals who meet income eli-
gibility requirements. The superintendent shall adopt
rules, pursuant to the Maine Administrative Procedure
Act, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II, setting in-
come eligibility requirements. The health insurer
shall be chosen by the superintendent after a competi-
tive bidding process.
