2 Tax and Rent Refund and Low Cost Drug

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §6111, sub-§2, as repealed and
8 replaced by PL 1979, c. 642, §2, is amended to read:

9 2. Age 54; not married. The claimant is current-
10 ly not married and has attained the age of 55 54 dur-
11 ing the year for which relief is requested and is,
12 due to disability, receiving federal disability pay-
13 ments, such as supplemental security income; or

14 Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §6111, sub-§3, as enacted by PL
15 1979, c. 642, §2, is amended to read:

1 3. Age 54; married. The claimant is currently
2 married and has attained the age of ~~55~~ 54 during the
3 year for which relief is requested and both the
4 claimant and the claimant's spouse are, due to dis-
5 ability, receiving federal disability payments, such
6 as supplemental security income.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 The purpose of this bill is to reduce the age
9 from 55 to 54 for those disabled individuals who
10 qualify for benefits under the Elderly Householders
11 Tax and Rent Refund Act and the Low Cost Drug Pro-
12 gram.
