This bill amends the eligibility requirements under the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act so that a couple who meet the income limitations may receive benefits if the claimant only is at least 55 years of age and is disabled. Currently, the law requires that both the claimant and the spouse be disabled.

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
