4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §682, sub-§2, as enacted by PL
7 1985, c. 161, §6, is amended to read:

8 2. Influence prohibited. Within the voting
9 place, no person may influence or attempt to influ-
10 ence another person's choice of candidates. This
11 limitation does not prohibit a candidate from attend-
12 ing the voting place and orally communicating with
13 voters, as long as he does not attempt to influence
14 their vote.
