AN ACT to Limit the Registration Fee on
Quasi-municipal and Municipal Dams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

38 MRSA §830, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

2-A. Exceptions. Notwithstanding subsection 2,
the annual registration fee for any dam which is
owned by a municipality or a quasi-municipal body may
not exceed \$5.
