Whereas, Acts of the Legis-12 13 lature do not become effective until 90 days after 14 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15 Whereas, the cost of post-secondary education is 16 escalating at a rapid pace; and Whereas, the trend in available financial aid is 17 toward loan programs and away from grants and schol-18 19 arship assistance; and 20 Whereas, these trends are forcing Maine students 21 to rely more heavily on borrowing to finance their 22 post-secondary education; and 23 Whereas, these trends may also be discouraging 24 some students from pursuing post-secondary study and 25 may be influencing the course of study and career se-26 lection of those who do attend; and 27 Whereas, it is in the best interests of the State to encourage as many students as possible to pursue 28 29 post-secondary study and to provide a broad range of career options to those who do so; and 30 31 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 32 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 33 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 34 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-35 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>§12602.</u>" in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "trust" and inserting in its place the following: 'plan'

7 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part 8 designated "<u>\$12604.</u>" in subsection 1 by striking out 9 all of paragraph E.

10 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part 11 designated "<u>§12604.</u>" in subsection 1 by relettering 12 paragraphs F to J to be E to I.

13 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part 14 designated "<u>§12611.</u>" by striking out all of subsec-15 tion 3.

16 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part 17 designated "<u>§12611.</u>" in subsection 13 in the last 18 line (page 13, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the 19 following: "<u>authority</u>" and inserting in its place the 20 following: 'board'

21 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part 22 designated "<u>§12611.</u>" by striking out all of subsec-23 tion 17 and inserting in its place the following:

 '17. Establish policies; promulgate rules. Establish policies and procedures and promulgate rules in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, including eligibility criteria and residency requirements to implement this Act.'

30 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part 31 designated "<u>§12611.</u>" by renumbering the subsections 32 to read consecutively.

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Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part

1 designated "<u>§12613.</u>" in subsection 2 in the 2nd line 2 (page 14, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the fol-3 lowing: "<u>State</u>" and inserting in its place the fol-4 lowing: '<u>board</u>'

5 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part 6 designated "<u>§12613.</u>" in subsection 3 in the 3rd line 7 (page 14, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the fol-10wing: "<u>State</u>" and inserting in its place the fol-9 lowing: 'board'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>§12619.</u>" in the last line (page 15, line 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "fund" and inserting in its place the following: 'board'

14 Further amend the bill by inserting before the 15 Statement of Fact the following:

16 'Sec. 3. Transition. In order to cover the initial administrative expenses of the Student Educational Enhancement Deposit Plan established in this Act, a one-time appropriation of \$25,000 is made from the General Fund. That money shall be paid back to the General Fund by the plan prior to July 1, 1989, from funds collected by the plan.

appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.

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10 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited 11 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-12 proved.

FISCAL NOTE

14 The bill results in a loss of General Fund revenues depending on the tax status of the plan. 15 If tax 16 exempt status is granted, earnings on investments 17 made will not be treated as income and income tax will not be paid on those earnings. Whether tax ex-18 empt status will be granted and how much revenue will 19 20 be lost to the General Fund cannot be determined at this time. There will be an increase in General Fund 21 revenue in fiscal year 1988-89 when the \$25,000 in start-up costs are paid back to the State by the 22 23 24 plan.
