1 AN ACT to Repeal the Fees for Hunting and
2 Fishing Licenses for Persons 65 Years of Age
3 or Older.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1983, c.
8 797, §3, is further amended to read:

9 1. Residents over 65 years of age. A complimen-
10 tary license to hunt, trap or fish shall be issued to
11 any resident of Maine who is ~~70~~ 65 years of age or
12 older and applies for it to the commissioner. The ap-
13 plication shall be accompanied by a birth certificate
14 or other certified evidence of the applicant's date
15 of birth and residency. Each license issued under
16 this subsection shall remain valid through December

1 31st of the 2nd complete calendar year following the
2 year of issuance.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This bill provides for complimentary hunting,
5 trapping and fishing licenses for residents 65 years
6 of age or older.

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
