IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Repeal the Fees for Hunting and Fishing Licenses for Persons 65 Years of Age or Older.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

7 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1983, c. 8 797, §3, is further amended to read:

1. <u>Residents over 65 years of age.</u> A complimentary license to hunt, trap or fish shall be issued to any resident of Maine who is 79 <u>65</u> years of age or older and applies for it to the commissioner. The application shall be accompanied by a birth certificate or other certified evidence of the applicant's date of birth and residency. Each license issued under this subsection shall remain valid through December
