COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 274, L.D. 784,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Check Cashing."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "\$1131."
in the first sentence in the 4th line (page 1, line
13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following:
"identification" the following: 'if the payor does
not possess a bank credit card'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a provision to clarify that a
merchant may ask for a credit card as proof of iden-
tification for check cashing, but may not require it
if a buyer does not possess a credit card. This
would not prohibit a merchant from requiring any oth-
er type of identification.
