AN ACT Concerning Smoking in Restaurants with at Least 50 Seats in the Dining Area.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

22 MRSA §1578-A is enacted to read:

7 §1578-A. Smoking in restaurants

<u>1.</u> Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context indicates otherwise, the following terms have the following meanings.

A. "Restaurant" means any enclosed indoor restaurant or other enclosed indoor establishment which invites the public to be served food for consumption on the premises and which contains at least 50 seats in the dining area.

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1B. "Smoking" means carrying or having in one's2possession a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or3other object giving off or containing any sub-4stance giving off tobacco smoke.

5 2. Policy; notice. A restaurant owner or his designee shall establish a written policy concerning б 7 smoking and nonsmoking by members of the public in 8 that restaurant. The policy must set aside at least 9 40% of the actual number of seats as a nonsmoking ar-10 ea. The policy shall prohibit smoking except in des-11 ignated smoking areas. The policy may prohibit smok-12 ing throughout the restaurant. The restaurant owner 13 his designee shall post and supervise the impleor 14 mentation of the policy.

15 The Bureau of Health shall accept inquiries from employers and employees and shall, when requested, assist employers in developing a policy.

18 <u>3. Violation. Failure to establish, post or su-</u> pervise the implementation of a policy is a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not more than \$100 21 may be adjudged.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that restaurants with 50 seats or more in the dining area establish and enforce a smoking policy. At least 40% of the actual number of seats must be set aside as a nonsmoking area.

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
