1 AN ACT Concerning Parking Violations at the
2 Capitol Complex.
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 25 MRSA §2910-A is enacted to read:

7 §2910-A. Parking violation

8 1. Fine. Notwithstanding section 2910, any per-
9 son who parks a motor vehicle in violation of any
10 rule concerning parking at the capitol complex com-
11 mits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not
12 less than \$10 and not more than \$25 may be adjudged.

13 2. Towing. The Commissioner of Public Safety
14 shall promulgate rules, pursuant to the Maine Admin-

1 Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, to au-
2 thorize removal of a vehicle parked in violation of
3 any rule concerning parking at the capitol complex
4 and may require the owner of any motor vehicle re-
5 moved pursuant to this subsection to pay a fee as set
6 by the commissioner to regain possession of the vehi-
7 cle.

8 STATEMENT OF FACT

9 The purpose of this bill is to institute a mini-
10 mum fine of \$10, with a maximum of \$25, for any park-
11 ing violation at the capitol complex. The bill also
12 allows the Commissioner of Public Safety to promul-
13 gate rules to allow the towing of any illegally
14 parked cars on the complex.

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
