Drinking while operating a motor vehicle 19 Definitions. As used in this section, <u>1.</u> unless context indicates otherwise, the following terms 20 the 21 have the following meanings. "Liquor" means any alcoholic, spirituous, vi-22 nous, fermented or other alcoholic beverage, or 23 24 combination of liquors and mixed liquors, in-25 tended for human consumption and which contains more than 1/2 of 1% of alcohol by volume. 26 27 2. Violation. No person may drink liquor while operating a motor vehicle on any public way. 28 3. Penalty. Any person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of 29 30 31 not more than \$500 may be adjudged.'
