11 Amend the bill by striking out all of subsection
12 8-A and inserting in its place the following:

13 '8-A. Guided parties. There shall be no more
14 than 12 people per each registered guide in a party
15 on any lake, stream or other waterway in this State.
16 This subsection is repealed on April 1, 1989.'

STATEMENT OF FACT


18 The purpose of this amendment is to ensure that
