5 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
6 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
7 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

8 Whereas, the guiding season for inland waters
9 runs from May to late September; and

10 Whereas, there is concern for the safety and
11 well-being of summer tourists, campers and residents
12 who pay for the professional services of a guide who
13 may overreach his guiding abilities by leading a party
14 that is too large; and
