Thomas P. Peters, II, as guardian ad litem in the adoption of Benjamin B., Heather B. and Lucas B.; compensated by the State. Resolved: That the Governor of the State is authorized and directed, upon receipt of the necessary releases, to pay \$3,288, from funds appropriated therefor, to Thomas P. Peters, II, attorney-at-law, for services rendered as guardian ad litem in the adoption of Benjamin B., Heather B. and Lucas B. The \$3,288 payment authorized by this resolve shall be in full satisfaction of any and all claims by Thomas P. Peters, II, against the State, in the matter of the adoption of Benjamin B., Heather B.
