	REGISTERED CONTAINER FOR BAKERY AND DAIRY PRODUCTS
5	31151. Definitions
_	As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

- 2. Container. "Container" means any bakery basket or tray, dairy case, egg basket or other bakery equipment.
- 9 3. Dairy case. "Dairy case" means a wire or plastic container which holds 16 quarts or more of packaged beverage and is used by a distributor, retailer or its agent as a means to transport, store or carry dairy products.

- 4. Egg basket. "Egg basket" means any permanent type of container which contains 4 dozen or more shell eggs and is used by a distributor, retailer or its agent as a means to transport, store or carry eggs.
- 5. Name or mark. "Name or mark" means any permanently affixed or permanently stamped name, mark or
 brand which has been registered with the Department
 of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources pursuant to
 section 1152 and is used for the purpose of identifying the registered owner of the containers.
 - 6. Other bakery equipment. "Other bakery equipment" means any other container, device or machine used in the production and distribution of baked goods or products.
- 7. Registered container. "Registered container"
 means a container bearing a name or mark.

- State may adopt for his exclusive use and ownership a 2 particular name or mark to be used on his containers. An owner may identify his containers by stamping, marking or fastening upon the containers any combina-3 5 tion of initials, symbols, designs or names constitute his name or mark. 2. Registration. Any person seeking to register his name or mark must: 9 A.  - 2. Possession. Any person, without the written consent of the registered owner or a bill of lading or invoice for products for which the container is used, who possesses, uses, sells or buys a registered container violates this chapter.

26	The purpose of this bill is to establish a method
27 .	for the registration of particular names or markings
28	on bakery basket and trays, dairy product cases and
29	egg baskets and to enact provisions to thwart the
30	misuse and theft of them.
