1                   **AN ACT to Establish Field Offices of the**  
2                   **Maine Land Use Regulation Commission.**

4                   Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
5 follows:

6                   12 MRSA §683-A is enacted to read:

7                   §683-A. Field Offices

8                   The commission shall maintain permanent field of-  
9                   ices in Greenville, Ashland and Rangeley. Each of  
10                   the offices shall be open full time and shall be  
11                   staffed by agents of the commission and such other  
12                   personnel as the commission may determine necessary.  
13                   Whenever practicable, the commission shall make use  
14                   of existing personnel to staff these field offices.

This bill requires the establishment of field offices for the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission in Greenville, Ashland and Rangeley to be open at least 2 days a month. This will increase communication between the commission and the persons being regulated. It will also expedite the process of obtaining permits.
