6	12 MRSA §683-A is enacted to read:
7	§683-A. Field Offices
8	The commission shall maintain permanent field of-
9	fices in Greenville, Ashland and Rangeley. Each of
0	the offices shall be open full time and shall be
1	staffed by agents of the commission and such other
2	personnel as the commission may determine necessary.
3	Whenever practicable, the commission shall make use
4	of existing personnel to staff these field offices.

2	This bill requires the establishment of field of-
3	fices for the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission in
4	Greenville, Ashland and Rangeley to be open at least
5	2 days a month. This will increase communication be-
