AN ACT Pertaining to the Placing of Bear
Bait.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

12 MRSA §7452-A is enacted to read:

§7452-A. Placing of bear bait

1. Use of bait. Bait may not be used to hunt
black bear, unless:

A. The person placing a bear bait holds a cur-
rent resident hunting license or guide license or
is a nonresident hunting with a licensed guide;
