§5804. Reports

1	A district attorney or the Attorney General shall
2	make a report to the office of the Attorney General
3	on the filing of a petition and on the entry of a fi-
4	nal order. That report shall describe the property
5.	to be seized, its estimated value and its final dis-
6	position. Beginning in January 1989, the Attorney
7	General shall report annually to the Governor and
8	the Legislature on seizures reported to him.
