18 The primary election shall be held on the 2nd Fuesday of June 2nd Tuesday of September of each gen-19 20 eral election year and is considered to be a separate 21 election for each party which takes part in it. This includes the duties of public officials in announcing 22 election, providing forms and ballots, keeping 23 the records and any other matter necessary to effect the 24 25 purpose of a primary election. A primary election 26 shall be conducted the same as the general election, 27 as nearly as practicable, for each party.

STATEMENT OF FACT

29 The purpose of this bill is to change the date 30 from the 2nd Tuesday in June to the 2nd Tuesday in 31 September for any statewide primary election.
