1 AN ACT to Extend the Time for the Rangeley
2 Water District to Purchase the
3 Rangeley Water Company Plant.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 P&SL 1983, c. 89, §19 is enacted to read:

8 Sec. 19. Extension of time to acquire Rangeley
9 Water Company. The operativeness of this chapter is
10 reinstated and the time provided for the district to
11 acquire the plant, property, franchises, rights and
12 privileges owned by the Rangeley Water Company as
13 specified in section 17, or to file a petition pursu-
14 ant to section 12 for taking the same, is extended to
15 March 31, 1988.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The Rangeley Water District was created in 1984
3 by enactment of Private and Special Law 1983, chapter
4 89 and by referendum in the district on November 6,
5 1984. Under section 17 the Act becomes inoperative if
6 the district fails to acquire the water company plant
7 or file a petition for that acquisition within 2
8 years. The 2 years ended without either of those
9 steps being taken. This bill extends the time for an
10 additional year and 4 months.
