1 AN ACT Relating to the Labeling of Milk.
2

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
4 follows:

5 7 MRSA §2903, as amended by PL 1985, c. 32, is
6 further amended by adding after the 15th paragraph a
7 new paragraph to read:

8 Any milk sold in this State shall bear conspicu-
9 ously on the front label the name of the state in
10 which the milk was produced, processed and packaged.
11 The name of the state shall be in print no less than
12 1/3 the height of the largest word "milk" on the la-
13 bel and shall be phrased in the following manner:
14 "Produced, processed and Packaged in" followed by the
15 name of the state in which it was processed and pack-
16 aged.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that labels on milk sold in
3 this State conspicuously name the state in which the
4 milk was processed and packaged.

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
