13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21	This amendment provides for a shift in revenues from the real estate transfer tax from the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund to the Local Government Fund. Currently, 1/2 of revenues go to the General Fund and 1/2 to the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund. Under this amendment 1/2 would go to the General Fund, 1/4 to the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund and 1/4 to the Local Government Fund for distribution through the state-municipal revenue sharing mechanism.
