AN ACT to Restore Status Offenses.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §3103, sub-§1, ¶E, as amended by PL 1985, c. 214, §1, is further amended to read:

Offenses involving the operation or attempted operation of a snowmobile or watercraft while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, as defined in Title 12, section 7801, subsection 9, and section 7827, subsection 9, respectively, and offenses involving failing to aid an injured person or to report a hunting accident as defined in Title 12, section 7406, subsection 15; and
