Under current law, the brewmaster at the brewery cannot sample the malt liquor to determine if the product is of the quality desired by the manufacturer. This bill allows the tasting or sampling for the purpose of quality control. The bill also allows sampling by wholesalers for the purpose of determining whether or not they want to distribute that product. Sampling by the public is also permitted in conjunction with a tour of the brewery, provided that, however, minors are not permitted to consume any product containing more than 1/2 of 1% alcohol by volume.

This bill allows the brewery to sell its products as a specialty package, which cannot be larger than one gallon. These sales can be made on the brewery premises, to be consumed off the premises.

This bill provides that the holder of the brewery license may sell to wholesalers, as well as hold one retail license. The retail license will permit the holder to sell the products of the brewery as well as other liquor. In selling the brewery products under the retail license for consumption on the premises, the licensee holding both the brewery license and the retail license does not have to sell the products wholesalers before selling the malt liquor at retail under the retail license. The retail license will apply to a location other than the actual brewery; although the brewery and the retail business can be located on the same real estate, they must operate completely separately. All other provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28, which apply to manufacturers of malt liquor also apply to breweries licensed under this new section.
