11 12 13	Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:
14 15	'Amend the Bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
16 17 18	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
19 20 21 22	Whereas, severe delays exist within the State's workers' compensation system, due in part to an increased number of cases to be decided by each workers' compensation commissioner; and
23 24 25 26	Whereas, these delays cause severe problems for injured workers whose decisions on their cases are delayed, including financial, emotional and other problems; and
27 28 29 30	Whereas, there is an immediate need to alleviate delay in the workers' compensation system and its accompanying human suffering and an immediate need for an additional workers' compensation commissioner; and
31 32 33	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following

legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
