8 9 .0 .1 .2 .3 .4 .5	1. Membership; term. The Workers' Compensation Commission, as established in this section, shall consist of 9 10 members, who shall be persons learned in the law and members of good standing of the bar of this State. They shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary and to confirmation by the Legislature. One of the commissioners, to be designated by the Governor as

chairman, shall be appointed for the term of 5 years and the other commissioners for a term of 4 years

each.
