Workers' Compensation Commission.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 39 MRSA §91, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1983, c.
7 479, §14, is amended to read:

8 1. Membership; term. The Workers' Compensation
9 Commission, as established in this section, shall
10 consist of 9 10 members, who shall be persons learned
11 in the law and members of good standing of the bar of
12 this State. They shall be appointed by the Governor,
13 subject to review by the joint standing committee of
14 the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary
15 and to confirmation by the Legislature. One of the
16 commissioners, to be designated by the Governor as

1 chairman, shall be appointed for the term of 5 years
2 and the other commissioners for a term of 4 years
3 each.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 The purpose of this bill is to increase the mem-
6 bers on the Workers' Compensation Commission from 9
7 to 10.
