"Employee" means a person acting on behalf of the governmental entity in any official capacity, whether temporarily or permanently, and whether with or without compensation from local, state or federal funds, including elected or appointed officials, volunteer firefighters as defined in Title 30, section 3771, rescue squad members where when the rescue squad receives full or partial financial support from political subdivisions or when the

2	National Guardsmen while in active state service un-
3	der Title 37-A, sections 57 and 207 and while engaged
4	in the Domestic Action Program, but the term "employ-
5	ee" shall not mean a person or other legal entity

7	under contract to the governmental entity.
