1 AN ACT Concerning the Payment of
2 Unemployment Insurance by Workers
3 in the Knitted Outerwear Industry.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 Home-knitter exemption; retroactivity. No claim
8 or action for employer's contribution to the Unem-
9 ployment Compensation Fund or interest or penalty as-
10 sessed pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title
11 26, chapter 13, may be brought against any person
12 performing services as a home knitter pursuant to the
13 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 1043, sub-
14 section 11, paragraph F, subparagraph (35), for any
15 period of employment after January 1, 1982.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make the exemption
3 from payment into the Unemployment Compensation Fund
4 for home knitters retroactive to January 1, 1982.

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
