AN ACT Concerning the Payment of
Unemployment Insurance by Workers
in the Knitted Outerwear Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Home-knitter exemption; retroactivity. No claim or action for employer's contribution to the Unemployment Compensation Fund or interest or penalty assessed pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, chapter 13, may be brought against any person performing services as a home knitter pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 1043, subsection 11, paragraph F, subparagraph (35), for any period of employment after January 1, 1982.
