3 4	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
5	29 MRSA §2508, sub-§1, ¶B is enacted to read:
6	B. Any person who operates or causes to be oper-
7	ated on the public highways of this State any
8	vehicle or combination of vehicles that has been
9	placed out-of-service by a uniformed police offi-
10	cer, except as otherwise provided in this chap-
11	ter, shall have committed a Class E crime.

The purpose of this bill is to discourage the operators of unsafe vehicles, which have been placed out-of-service by a police officer from driving their vehicle without making the appropriate repairs. This bill increases the penalty for this violation from a misdemeanor to Class E crime.

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
