AN ACT Relative to Notification of Adoption

4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6	19 MRSA §533, 3rd ¶ is amended to read:
7 8 9 0	A certified copy of the birth record of the child proposed for adoption shall be presented with the petition for adoption, provided such a certified copy can be obtained or can be made available by filing adoption had been birth registration.
1 2 3 4	delayed birth registration. After the adoption has been decreed the register of probate shall forthwith file a certificate of adoption with the State Registrar of Vital Statistics on a form prescribed and
5 6	furnished by the State Registrar of Vital Statistics. Within 30 days of issuance of the adoption decree the

1 2 3 4	register of probate shall provide written notification to the biological parents of record as to the date of adoption finalization and to the Probate Court having jurisdiction.
5	STATEMENT OF FACT
6 7 8 9 10	This bill requires that within 30 days, upon issuance of a final adoption decree, notification will be made to the biological parents of record as to the date of finalization and to the Probate Court having jurisdiction.
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
