COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 654, L.D. 882,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Truck Size and Weight
Laws."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the
following:

'Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §1652, sub-§1, ¶D, as repealed
and replaced by PL 1975, c. 237, §4, is amended to
read:

D. The following vehicles are permitted on the
Interstate Highway System:

(1) All 3-axle trucks with brakes on the
wheels of all axles, hauling forest products
or raw ore from mine or quarry to place of
processing, may be operated with a gross
weight of 48,000 pounds with a distance be-
tween extreme axles of not less than 18
feet; and

(2) All 3-axle trucks with brakes on the
wheels of all axles, hauling construction
materials, may be operated with a gross
weight of 48,000 pounds with a distance be-
tween extreme axles of not less than 16
feet; and

(3) A combination comprised of a motor ve-
hicle hauling any tank trailer, dump trailer
or ocean transport container with a combined
weight of 68,000 pounds on the tandems of
the tractor and the trailer, provided that
the distance between the first and last ax-
les of those tandems is 30 feet or more.
