1 Whereas, the Town of Trenton voted on November 4,
2 1986, at referendum to authorize the selectmen to
3 borrow additional funds not to exceed \$69,000 for
4 that project and to borrow and expend an amount not
5 to exceed \$16,000 for the purpose of purchasing, in-
6 stalling and relocating a new fuel oil storage tank
7 at the Trenton Elementary School; and

8 Whereas, certain procedural errors were made in
9 preparing the warrants and ballots for the referenda,
10 including the omission of the informational state-
11 ments required by Title 20-A, section 15904, subsection
12 4, and the omission of the recommendations of
13 the selectmen and school committee as required by Ti-
14 tle 30, section 2061, subsection 4; and

15 Whereas, these errors and omissions did not af-
16 fect the substance of the proceedings and may prevent
17 the Town of Trenton from issuing bonds or notes for
18 the project unless the Legislature validates and ap-
19 proves proceedings of these referendum votes; and

20 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
21 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
22 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
23 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
24 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
25 therefore,

26 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
27 follows:

28 Town of Trenton; referendum validated. Notwith-
29 standing the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, sec-
30 tion 15904, subsection 4; Title 30, section 2061,
31 subsection 4; and any other provisions of law, the
32 referendum votes conducted by the Town of Trenton on
33 July 8, 1986, and November 4, 1986, for the purpose
34 of authorizing the municipal officers of the Town of
35 Trenton to borrow and expend up to \$269,000 for the
36 purpose of constructing an addition to the Trenton
37 Elementary School and to borrow and expend an amount
38 not to exceed \$16,000 for the purpose of purchasing,
39 installing and relocating a new fuel oil storage tank
40 at the Trenton Elementary School are hereby validated
41 and approved and the municipal officers of the Town
42 of Trenton are authorized to issue bonds or notes of
