8 F. The open season in Aroostook County for all  
9 fish in rivers, brooks and streams is May 1st to  
10 September 15th; and

11 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶G, as enacted by  
12 PL 1983, c. 274, §3, is amended to read:

13 G. There shall be a continued closed season on  
14 the dipping of smelts from Morrill Pond and its  
15 tributaries in Somerset County; and
