SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 662, L.D. 895,
Bill, "AN ACT to Extend Maine's Bottle Bill."

Amend the Bill in subsection 1 by striking out
all of the last underlined sentence (page 1, lines 10
to 12 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the follow-
ing: "Beverage" also includes wine coolers. "Wine
cooler" means a beverage containing wine and more
than 15% added natural or artificial blending materi-
al, such as fruit juices, flavors, flavorings or
adjuncts; plain, carbonated or sparkling water; col-
oring; or preservatives, and which contains less than
7% of alcohol by volume.'


