the first line after the enacting clause (page 1,

1979, c. 735, is further amended to read:

4. Reimbursement by distributor. In addition to
the payment of the refund value, the distributor
shall reimburse the dealer or local redemption center
for the cost of handling beverage containers, in an
amount which equals at least 2¢ per returned contain-
er and 2 1/2¢ per returned wine cooler container.


