**AN ACT to Extend Maine's Bottle Bill.**

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
4 follows:

5 32 MRSA §1862, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1975, c.  
6 739, §16, is amended to read:

7 1. Beverage. "Beverage" means beer, ale or other  
8 drink produced by fermenting malt, soda water or oth-  
9 er nonalcoholic carbonated drink in liquid form and  
10 intended for human consumption. "Beverage" also in-  
11 cludes wine coolers which are defined as a beverage  
12 made with table wine.
