IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Extend Maine's Bottle Bill.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
32 MRSA §1862, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 739, §16, is amended to read:
1. <u>Beverage</u> . "Beverage" means beer, ale or other drink produced by fermenting malt, soda water or other er nonalcoholic carbonated drink in liquid form and intended for human consumption. "Beverage" also includes wine coolers which are defined as a beverage made with table wine.
