AN ACT to Insure Clean-up Capability by
Persons Undertaking Movement of
Hazardous Materials.

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5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

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22 MRSA §1471-U is enacted to read:

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§1471-U. Damage control and procedures

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1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless
the context otherwise indicates, the following terms
have the following meanings.

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A. "Chemical substances" means all insecticides,
pesticides, herbicides and fungicides and any
other poisons or hazardous chemicals.
