11	known as Elm Street in Biddeford and Saco, crosses
12	the Case Diver to Chelter Dev et Maior Fella

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife granted a waiver to allow waterskiing on a certain part of the Saco River upon the request for waiver by the Biddeford City Council. The city council then voted to withdraw the request, but the department has not rescinded the waiver. This bill makes the waiver ineffective and prohibits waterskiing on the Saco River from the point where Route 1 crosses the river to Shelton Dam at Union Falls.
