1 AN ACT to Amend the Tuition Computation Rate
2 for Secondary Schools.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §5805, sub-§1, ¶D, as enacted
7 by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

8 D. The tuition rate thus determined shall be ad-
9 justed by the average change in public secondary
10 education costs for the 2 years immediately be-
11 fore the school year for which the tuition charge
12 is computed. This adjustment shall be limited to
13 a 6% increase.

14 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §5805, sub-§2, as enacted by
15 PL 1981, c. 693, §§ 5 and 8, is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to remove limitations on tuition charges for high school students to more accurately reflect the actual cost of the education of tuition students.

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
